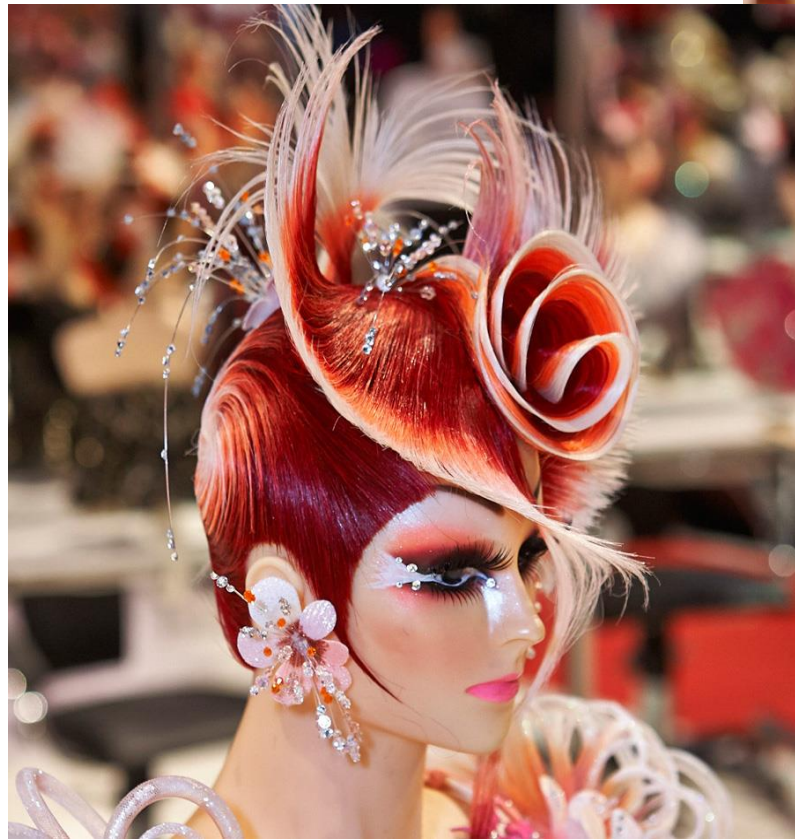

Allergy

- ▶ Possible contact to allergenic substances
- ▶ Hair dye: PPD and resorcinol
- ▶ Bleaching agents: Persulfates
- ▶ Metals: Nickel
- ▶ Preservatives
- ▶ Gloves: latex and rubber chemicals
- ▶ Perfume
- ▶ Hair dye and bleaching agents, the two most common work related allergens in hairdressers (10% of all tested hairdressers)

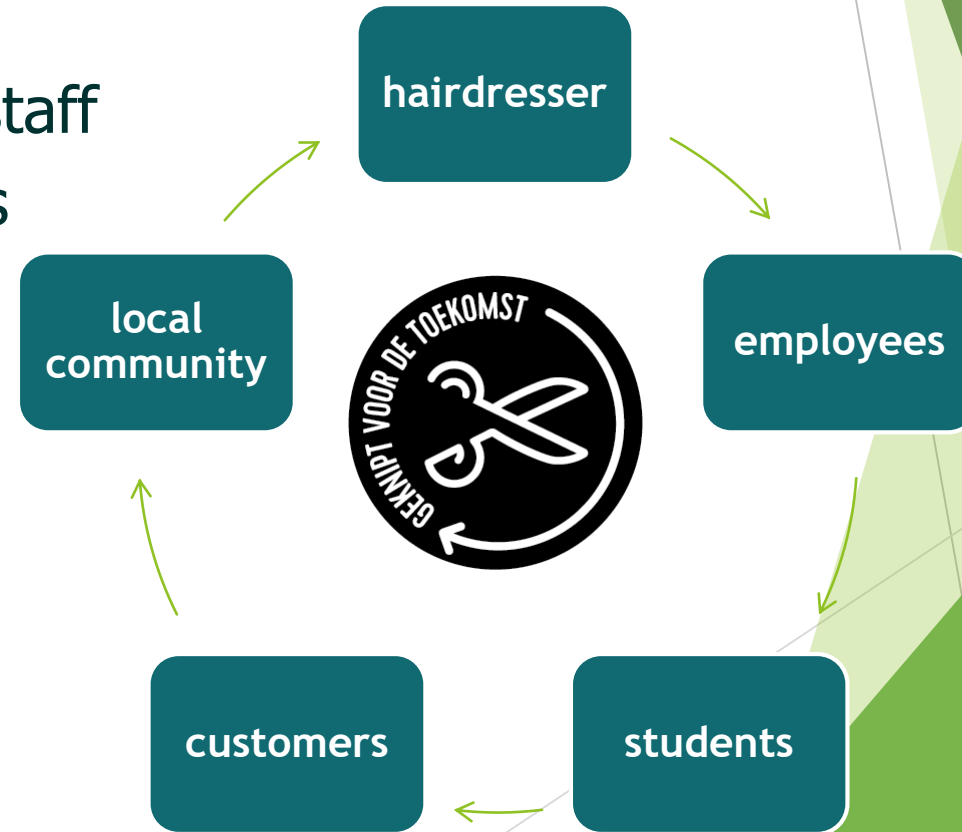
